- Overseeing the preparation & coaching of our U/13 McDonalds Female Country Champs Team
- Preparing & Coaching our Female Teams for any other competition as designated by Greater Illawarra Committee, or Greater Illawarra Women's Zone Representative.
- Oversee & be involved in coaching appointments for all Greater Illawarra Female Junior Teams in consultation with Coach & Talent Specialist. Greater Illawarra Women's Representative to have final say.
- Encourage and develop the participation of women in coaching roles

- Current Play by the Rules Child Protection certificate
- Current Member Protection Declaration
- Current Police Check

Desirable Requirements:

- Previous Coaching experience
- Previous or Current Grade Playing experience
- Previous Coaching experience minimum 1st Grade
- First Aid Certificate
- Excellent Communicator

Coach Expectations:

- Lead Greater Illawarra to on field success
- Attend Coach Education sessions conducted within Greater Illawarra, in conjunction with CNSW Coach & Talent specialist.

- Complete reviews as requested by Greater Illawarra committee or Greater Illawarra's Women's Zone Representative
- Abide by Greater Illawarra's Code of Conduct
- Arrange team selection trials (where appropriate)
- Organise & attend all training sessions, trials & games
- Provide input to Team selection
- Identify & develop local players in line with set pathways

- Coordinate training programs
- Develop a game plan that enhances performance
- Provide a training & playing environment that allows players to fulfil their potential
